Must be 16 years of age, RC Lifeguard Certified w/ WATERFRONT, CPR & First Aid

Waterfront lifeguards are responsible for the safety of swimmers at a waterfront facility. Their duties include:

- Enforcing rules: Lifeguards ensure that swimmers follow the rules and guidelines for the waterfront.
- Monitoring swimmers: Lifeguards keep an eye on swimmers to ensure their safety.
- Responding to emergencies: Lifeguards respond to emergencies, such as injuries or distressed swimmers, and provide first aid and CPR.
- Maintaining the waterfront: Lifeguards keep the waterfront clean and free of hazards. They also inspect the equipment and facilities to ensure they are safe. This includes raking the sand, cleaning the docks, clearing the beach of geese poop.
- Preparing reports: Lifeguards prepare reports and check lists as required.

Head guards are responsible for same duties as Junior Guard as well as:

- Overseeing the daily operations of the beach: opening the closing of the beaches, following protocol for
 equipment setup and cleaning procedures. Making sure all equipment is properly stored and locked at the end
 of each shift.
- Providing guidance and training to junior guards
- Regularly check that safety equipment, such as rescue tubes, AEDs, and first aid kits, are in working condition.
- Track inventory for safety equipment and supplies, ensuring there is always enough stock.
- Report any hazards or unsafe conditions to management.
- Make sure all documents & logs are filled out correctly at the end of each shift.
- Interact with patrons to provide information, answer questions, and ensure they are following safety rules. Promote a positive, welcoming environment for all guests.
- Serve as a point of contact between guards and management.
